

Free timers still available to help deter criminal activity



Free timers that enable residents to leave a light on in their properties, which helps to deter criminal activity, are still available from our Customer Service Centre and contact points.

In partnership with Nottinghamshire Police, we are still encouraging residents to collect a 24-hour timer from the centres to switch lights on at specific times and reduce the number of hours their home is left in darkness.

If a house does not have any lights on, it is more likely to be targeted by burglars who could assume it is unoccupied.

Residents are reminded that they can claim a limited supply timer by completing a Neighbourhood Alert Registration Form with a Customer Service advisor and collecting the tool at one of the following locations:
