THE VILLAGE ENVIRONMENT

We are proud of our village and surroundings, and all wish to live in a safe and clean environment.

Dog Walking – The majority of walkers are most responsible keeping their pets on a lead on the streets. Dogs are not allowed to go on the Memorial Playing fields where children play. Please ensure your dogs are on their leads through fields with sheep and horses or adjacent footpaths.

Doggy poo bags are freely available from the Clerk and dog waste bins are spread around the village. Please report any owner abusing and spoiling our environment – Parish Clerk 0115 9894656

Pedestrian Safety – Whilst encouraging the use of bicycles and walking locally, the Parish Council is aware of the hazards of narrow pavements, parking issues and speeding traffic. The Parish Council has invested in speed warning signs and would support a 20mph speed limit in the central section of the village if this is achievable. Please take care.

Litter – We appreciate that Villagers are careful to take their litter home or use the bins provided, thank you. Unfortunately, litter does accumulate, often from inconsiderate passing motorists. A team of volunteers, The Cropwell Bishop Litter Picking Group help to keep our village free of litter.
